Institutional nature

MYCDIC is an international youth institution advancing diplomacy, international cooperation, structured leadership, dialogue, and responsible global engagement.

This public edition summarizes the Council's mission, governance principles, institutional safeguards, and public operating framework.

Purpose and mission

The Council supports youth diplomacy, international cooperation, civic leadership, cultural dialogue, peace-oriented initiatives, and institutional partnerships.

Activities are implemented through approved offices, representations, programs, public resources, and competent institutional decisions.

Governance

The Presidency, General Secretariat, National Office, International Office, oversight bodies, advisory bodies, and other approved units operate within the official structure of the Council.

Public appointment notices, approved institutional documents, and competent decisions remain the authoritative references for roles and mandates.

Membership and conduct

Membership, applications, appointments, renewals, and internal responsibilities are subject to eligibility, review, conduct standards, confidentiality duties, and institutional approval.

No public page, badge, title, or document creates state, embassy, consular, governmental, or diplomatic-agent authority.

Transparency and protection

MYCDIC publishes selected public documents to support transparency and institutional clarity. Private identifiers, signatures, verification credentials, and internal-only information are excluded from public versions unless disclosure is required.
